3. Introduction

Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM) has added impetus to sanitation and waste management across India. In line with SBM, Uttar Pradesh State Industrial Development Authority has taken up multiple initiatives to improve sanitation and waste management activities. List of Industrial Areas can be obtained from website "https://onlineupsida.com"

Due to rapid growth in industrial areas, management of electronic waste is becoming a challenge. Therefore, it is required to implement sustainable electric waste management projects. UPSIDA intends to engage an end-to-end service provider for management of E-waste generated within various industrial areas of UPSIDA. The scope would include collection, transportation, processing and reuse/ scientific disposal of E-waste.

In view of this, UPSIDA wants to encourage firms that are involved in collection transportation and processing of waste on a smaller scale and self-sustainable model.

As per the E-Waste (Management) Rules 2016 "e-waste' means electrical and electronic equipment, whole or in part discarded as waste by the consumer or bulk consumer as well as rejects from manufacturing, refurbishment and repair processes."

E-waste can be collected in several categories as defined in the E-waste management rules such as laptops, mobiles phones, earphones etc. are as a whole or their spare parts. The segregated items can further break to its smallest unit level and make new products out of them. They can also extract precious materials from collected E-waste.

Objective

The key objectives of the project are as follows:

- a) Modern and scientific E-waste collection and transportation, processing, and disposal as per E-waste management rule 2016 & E-waste amended rules 2018 in Industrial areas of UPSIDA
- b) To effect behavioral change regarding healthy sanitation practices & good waste management
- c) Generate awareness about necessity of E-waste management.
- d) Capacity Augmentation of Authority in the desired sectors

4. Scope of Work

UPSIDA invites "Expression of Interest" from the entities/ operators/ NGOs interested to show case their interest in collection, transportation, processing & disposal of electronic waste.

The agency is required to carry out electronic waste management across residential, industrial, commercial, institutional areas and etc of Industrial areas of UPSIDA. In order to achieve it, the required agency has to develop a mechanism of collection, transportation and recycling / disposal in accordance with E-waste management rules, 2016 & E-waste amended rules 2018.

Intended scope for E-Waste Management include, but not limits to following activities.

- i. Collection of E-waste from designated collection points. Vendor will also be responsible to carry out IEC activities for awareness and behavioral change and encourage citizens for source segregation of e-waste
- ii. Mobilizing resources for collection, transportation and processing
- iii. Civil Construction of the treatment/ processing facility including land levelling, foundation, super structure etc.
- iv. Construction and operation of the processing facility using suitable technology
- v. Segregation of waste and selling it to authorized dealers vi. Sale of recovered material from the processing of waste
- vi. Ensuring tie ups/ adequate arrangements to disposing off hazardous waste
- vii. Storage facility for e-waste.
- viii. Setting up IT system for monitoring operations (CCTV, data management, digital weighment system etc.)
- ix. Vendor will be required to obtain necessary permissions/approvals from relevant authority for specific processes/machineries it proposes to use at the facility (as applicable)

A general overview of responsibilities is mentioned below:

Responsibilities of UPSIDA

- i. Finalizing and earmarking land for setting up the project.
- ii. Facilitate the Concessionaire in obtaining requisite permits, approvals, NOCs etc.
- iii. Access road/ electricity/ water/ streetlight/ drainage/ sewer will be provided by the UPSIDA up to the Plot, if required.
- iv. Providing room in UPSIDA office for setting up control room, if required

Responsibilities of Vendor

- i. Deploy adequate number of equipment's and manpower for smooth execution collection, transportation, processing and disposal.
- ii. Establish market linkages for by-products from waste processing.
- iii. Timely submit monthly reports to the Authority.
- iv. Ensure compliance with various laws and regulations applicable from time to time.
- v. Ensure availability and timely renewal of requisite permits, consents, and NOCs.
- vi. Set-up a complaint redressal mechanism and ensure timely resolution of complaints.
- vii. Hand over peaceful possession of the site to Authority, upon completion or termination of contract, without any encumbrances and liability whatsoever

UPSIDA will allocate land for secondary storage, processing and treatment. However, ownership of the land will remain with UPSIDA in accordance with the Uttar Pradesh state solid waste policy and applicable rules and regulations.

Proposed revenue streams are sale of end products from treated waste. Explore potential methods of compensating UPSIDA with mutual agreement from both parties.

The approval will be with the following conditions:

- i. The land assigned to the developer would not be used for any other activity expect for approved project activities.
- ii. The project proponent is not allowed to mortgage the land or take loan the land.
- iii. UPSIDA will not provide any funds for the establishment of plants.
- iv. Access road/ electricity/ water/ streetlight/ drainage/ sewer will be provided by the UPSIDA up to the outer boundary of the site/battery limit.
- v. The concessionaire will be entitled to sale or charge for the products and byproducts produced in the process of E-waste management.
- vi. The Agency have to fulfil E-waste management rules-2016& E-waste amended rules 2018 and other applicable Government Norms.
- vii. The Agency have to obtain required permission from concern Department at his
- viii. In case of non-implementation of Plant within 03 Years, the land will automatically go back to UPSIDA. However, the ownership of land shall always remain with UPSIDA.
- ix. The concessionaire must submit an affidavit. If performance standards are not met after three notices, the concessionaire may be asked to vacate. UPSIDA reserves the right to reclaim the land.
- x. The concessionaire has to bear all electricity charge, water charge, running cost (Capex/Opex) within the site, site development & any other charge and tax liabilities at his own cost.
